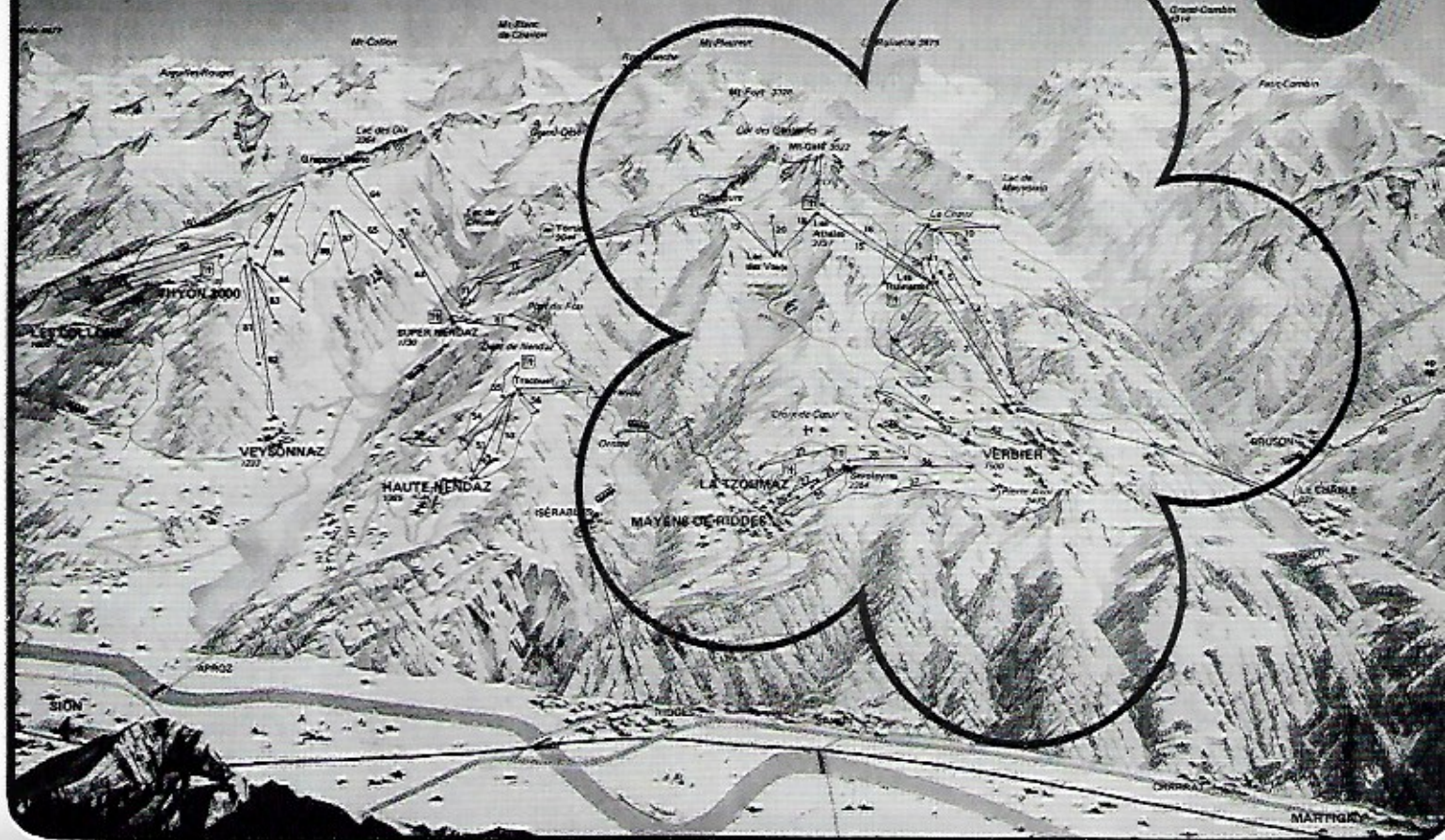

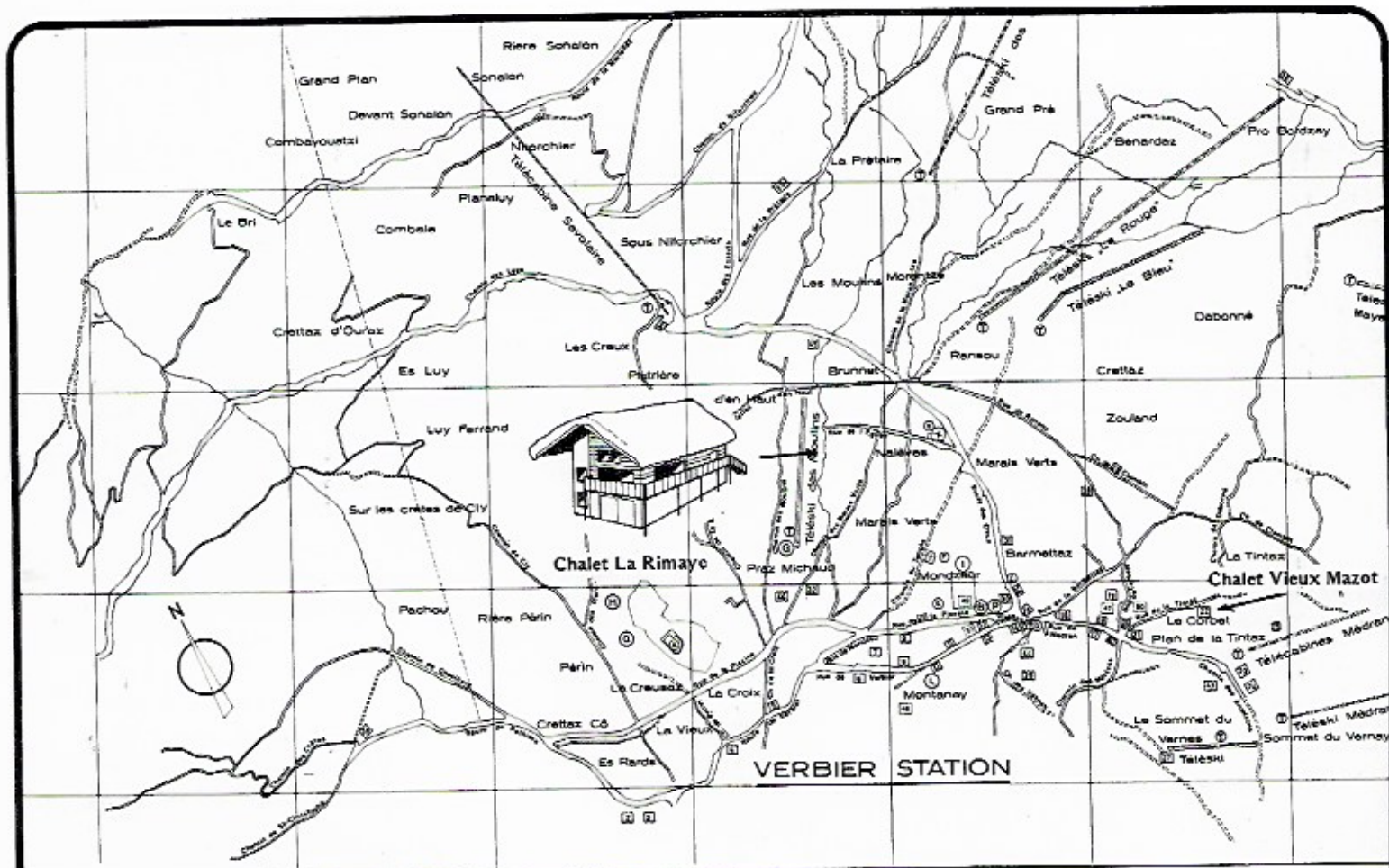
Skiing in Verbier

Set in an open bowl under the protection of the Gele Mountain, Verbier is probably one of the best ski resorts in the Swiss Alps, combining long hours of sunshine with magnificent views and only about 3 hours drive from Geneva. It has a friendly village atmosphere with most of the accommodation in chalets, but with every modern facility at hand. Verbier has been known for many years for its good on and off piste skiing and today, with the neighbouring 3 valleys now accessible (all on the same abonnement), it has over 150 km of tracks and pistes for all standards. Constant improvements are always being made and at the last count there were well over 50 lifts, cableways and bus connections spread between the four valleys, ensuring easy access and quick returns to the upper slopes—'A skier's dream'.

Verbier itself offer a good ski school on gentle nursery slopes with qualified instructors for all standards; a few

lessons may always be worthwhile to get back into the run of things. Those parents who wish to ski without having to keep an eye on young children, can leave them in the expert hands of the kindergarten. For the non-skier (or those at rest), a variety of other activities is available; these include swimming (indoor and heated), ice skating, curling, cinema and sauna, and of course there are many cafes, restaurants and bars in which to meet and a variety of shops offering all the latest goods.

Après ski is just as enjoyable following a hard day on the slopes. The evenings should start with a drink in the Phenix Bar, where most people will pass to chat with the Ski Club of Great Britain Rep. or to meet friends, then up to the chalet for dinner or a local restaurant and afterwards a visit to one of the many night clubs to dance the midnight hours away. The Rodeo Club is worth at least one visit, if not more!

Chalet La Rimaye

The chalet is traditional in style and comprises four double bedrooms (one with bunk beds) and a further two beds, making accommodation for up to 10 persons (a cot is also available), bathroom, separate toilet, dining/drawing room with an open fire and kitchen. There is a central heating system which feeds radiators in all rooms and supplies constant hot water. The drawing room leads onto a balcony which catches the best of the sun.

La Rimaye is located near the top of the practice teleski lift of Les Moulins and about ten minutes walk from the centre; a short walk up the track to the main road will enable visitors to catch the ski bus (included in the abonnement) to the telecabine lift of Medran or Savoleyres and thence the upper slopes.

Services

A chalet girl will prepare breakfast and dinner each day (except her day off) and clean the chalet in the morning while visitors are out piste bashing. She will also be able to help you with any discounts that are available on things like ski hire and abonnements.

Chalet Vieux Mazot

This is an ideally situated chalet for those who wish for little more than to be able to roll out of bed straight on to the cableway to Les Ruinettes; however the accommodation is slightly simpler, comprising three double bedrooms, bathroom, kitchen and dining room and complete with central heating.

Services will only be provided on special request; otherwise it will be available on a self-catering basis only.

Further Accommodation

Verbier offers a number of hotels from the usual Bed and Breakfast to the more luxurious hostleries. Should your group require additional accommodation to that offered in the chalets, we will be very happy to quote and obtain these extra rooms for you (a small service charge of £5 will be made to cover telephone and telex expenses).

Dates and Costs

Flight Timings
